



ONLINE COURSE GUIDE - EUROPE INCLUDE YOU

ABOUT THE COURSE

This course focuses on the issues of Inclusive Educational Practices and in a more specific way those related to Minorities, Migrants and Refugees, having as a backdrop, artistic expression in a broad sense, developed in the Eu Includes You Project, carried out in the triennium of 2017 to 2020. It is designed to help education professionals, especially teachers, to develop and apply inclusive teaching and learning methods. The course will provide the debate of ideas on the subject in discussion forums and the sharing of experiences and activities of a practical nature. The course is given in English, it is free in a b-learning system, that is, with face-to-face classes in videoconference mode and autonomous working time. The course is given and managed through the Classroom Platform.

COURSE OBJECTIVES

The general objective of the course is to share inclusive educational practices through the arts and applied to minorities, refugees and migrants. More specifically, it is intended:

- Present an inclusive work methodology;
- Share real situations of applicability of these practices;
- Develop inclusive practice learning scenarios

METHODOLOGY

The course will follow a formative methodology based on discussions in forums and practical activities. Participants will create an individual Portfolio, to gather their reflections and the respective practical activities. The assessment will be made, based



on this portfolio, based on two principles. The principle of self-assessment by each participant and an external view provided by an international jury, composed of a representative from each country that participated in the Eu includes You project.

There are an estimated 25 hours of work over this course.

CONTENTS

The Europe Includes You Course is structured in six core modules, the first dedicated to the Introduction and the sixth dedicated to its conclusion. each module is framed in a sequence lasting one week.

- Why inclusion through the arts.

Module IV - Methodologies

- Methodologies used. Sharing Practices.

Module V - Explore educational tools and resources

- Exploration of Europe Includes You. Its tools and resources.

Module VI- Design learning scenarios based in Europe Includes You

- Creation of inclusive learning scenarios according to the model and methodologies of activities developed in the project.
